May 21, 2024

Commissioner Torgrimson, being in the chair and a quorum present, the meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm.

- 3. Consider and take appropriate action on the minutes of the April 16, 2024 Regular meeting: Commissioner Clark made the motion to accept the minutes of the April 16, 2024 regular meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Laryea and passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present.
- 4. Consider and take appropriate action on the April 2024 treasurer's report which may include other reports: Commissioner Alexander made the motion to approve the April 2024 treasurers' reports and was seconded by Commissioner Clark. - 5. <u>Update on the TexPool Investment report:</u> Ms. Logan reviewed the April 2024 TexPool Investment Summary Report with the commissioners.
- 6. <u>Discussion on property taxes, budget and timetable:</u> Chief Bailey stated that he will need a copy of the signed minutes to send to Travis Central Appraisal District in order to set the Exemptions Over 65 to \$400,000. (four hundred thousand dollars) by the June 28 due date. Ms. Logan

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stated she would scan and send them in a timely manner. She also stated that the draft budget would be ready for review at the June 18th meeting with the proposed FY25 budget set for the July meeting and adoption in August.

- 7. Consider and take appropriate actions on the District Administrator's report to include updates on the AFD contract for services, District Office updates and other administrative topics: See attached report. Commissioner Laryea made the motion to approve Chief Bailey to enter into negotiations with bidder number one (1) as the general contractor for the Station 47 remodel and was seconded by Commissioner Clark. The motion passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present.
- 8. Review and Approve Pending Disbursements: Commissioner Clark made the motion to approve the pending disbursements and was seconded by Commissioner Laryea. The motion passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present. Check detail attached.




