- 1. Open meeting: Commissioner Torgrimson called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.
- 2. Public Comments: None
- Consider and take appropriate action on the minutes of the July 16, 2024 meeting:
 Commissioner Laryea made the motion to approve the July 16, 2024 meeting minutes and was seconded by Commissioner Opiela. The motion passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present.
- 4. Consider and take appropriate action on the July 2024 treasurer's report, which may include other reports: Commissioner Opiela made the motion to approve the July 2024 treasurer's report and was seconded by Commissioner Clark. - 5. <u>Update of the TexPool Investment:</u> Ms. Logan reviewed the July TexPool Investment report with all commissioners.
- 6. <u>Adopt FY25 Budget:</u> Commissioner Opiela made the motion to adopt the FY25 budget as presented and was seconded by Commissioner Clark. The motion passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present.

- 7. Adopt the 2024 Tax Rate: Commissioner Clark made the motion to adopt the 2024 tax rate at \$.03/\$100 valuation and was seconded by Commissioner Laryea. After discussion, Commissioner Opiela made the motion to adopt the 2024 tax rate at \$.0275/\$100 valuation. There was not a second. The motion did not pass. The roll call to adopt the 2024 tax rate at \$.03/\$100 valuation is as follows: Commissioners Torgrimson, Clark and Laryea voting Aye and Commissioner Opiela voting Nay. Commissioner Alexander was not present and did not vote. The 2024 tax rate was set at \$.03/\$100 valuation.
- 8. <u>Discuss and take and take appropriate action on regarding payment to TCESD#6 for wildfire removal services:</u> Commissioner Opiela made the motion to approve the payment to TCESD#6 for wildfire removal services. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Clark and passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present.
- 9. Consider and take appropriate action regarding reimbursement to TCESD#12 for costs associated with the renovation of the Modular building at station 48: Commissioner Opiela made the motion to approve the renovation costs for the Modular building at station 48 to be reimbursed to TCESD#12 in the amount of \$69,841.24 and was seconded by Commissioner Clark. The motion passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present.
- 10. Consider and take appropriate action on aligning ESD#4's medical response with AFD's: After discussing the Priority calls designated as 3,4 and 5, Captain Beals stated he would provide a monthly report on those types of calls. No further action taken.
- 11. Consider and take appropriate actions on the District Administrator's report to include updates on the AFD contract for services, District Office updates and other administrative topics: See attached report.
- 12. Review and Approve Pending Disbursements: Commissioner Opiela made the motion to approve the pending disbursements and was seconded by Commissioner Clark. The motion passed unanimously by a show of hands among those present. Check detail attached.






